Application Guidelines:

- The applicant must be a **law student** in good standing with his or her school who has an interest in practicing aviation law.
- The applicant must be a **member of the State Bar of Texas Aviation Law Section**, or must fill out the attached application to be **automatically enrolled** for free.
- The applicant will submit a brief of **500 words or less** covering an **aviation case opinion** that was **decided in 2019 or 2020**.
- The brief must be submitted in **PDF form** via email to Paula Knippa (paula@knippalaw.com) and Morgan Schweinzger (mschweinzger@winstead.com) by **April 1, 2020**.
- Applications will be judged on the following criteria:
 - Technical writing skill, including compliance with the BlueBook and GreenBook;
 - Flow of narrative;
 - Applicability of case selected to aviation law as a whole; and/or
 - Interest in aviation law.
